What can I do to go the extra mile?

Whatever you choose to do, we want you to go the extra mile for your local air ambulance.

Get creative with your ideas on how to take part, we have put together some ideas to get you started.









Daily activity:

- Set a personal goal for daily activities such as swimming, running, or rowing
- Organise group fitness sessions at your local gym or in the workplace
- Encourage colleagues or classmates to participate in a daily exercise routine

Challenges:

- Sign up for a skydive experience
- Take on a bungee jump or plan a rock climbing experience
- Organise a workplace or school-wide adventure club for the month
- Organise community or workplace-wide events like group hikes or bike rides

Get creative:

- Hold a fancy dress challenge where participants wear unique costumes every day
- Host a costume competition with daily themes to keep the excitement high
- Use YouTube to take part in workshops to learn new skills such as cooking classes, art sessions, or coding

Random acts of kindness:

- Use our tracker calendar to fill each day with acts for individuals or groups to perform in school or the workplace
- Organise a volunteer day

Themed days:

- Designate specific days for themed activities such as an adventure day or skill swap day
- Host a bring and share lunch in the workplace using a theme as inspiration
- Hold an eco-month to set challenges such as a daily waste reduction goal or tree planting within the workplace, school or at home
